Senna Control in Littoral Rainforest

What is it about?

Please join us for our second hit removing Senna and assist the recovery of a patch of Littoral Rainforest in a remote part of Moonee Beach Nature Reserve north of Emerald Beach, behind Fiddamans Beach.

Our goal is to remove the Senna and other weeds. This will help the recovery of Littoral Rainforest and Melaleuca Forest behind the Diggers Point headland north of the township of Emerald Beach.

Last year 15 people participated with a total of 56 hours of work! We removed an enormous amount of Senna. See photos below of our team's work.

When

If unfavourable weather, event will be postponed until 6th of November or until better conditions.

Meet

Take the Emerald Beach exit off highway and through roundabout north toward Sandy Beach past the Shell service station. Approximately 400 metres north of the Shell service station there is a fire trail with a gate. It is about a 1km walk along the track to the work site. A NPWS 4WD will carry the equipment to the work area. See map overpage.

Gloves, sturdy shoes, hat, water bottle, insect repellent, morning tea, picnic lunch. Swimmers and towel if you want a refreshing dip at Fiddamans Beach
