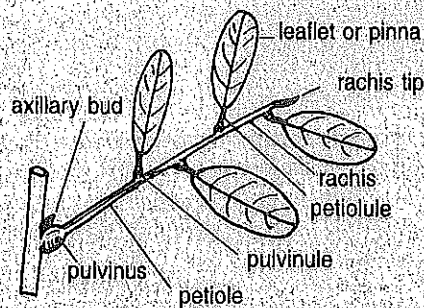

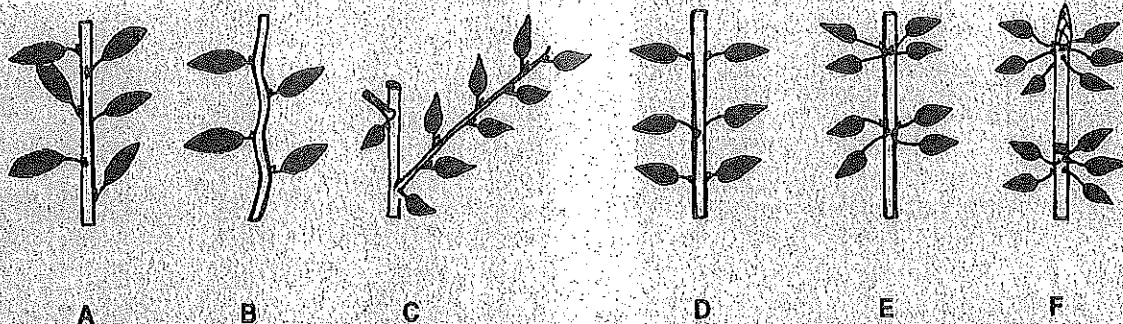
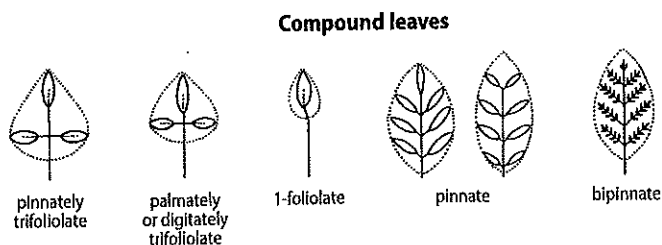
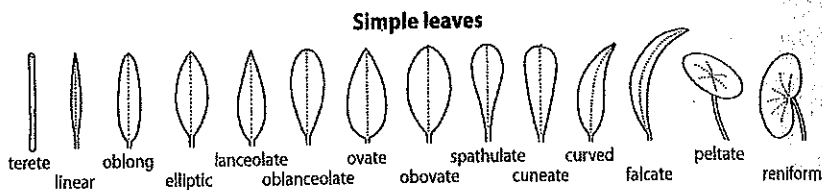


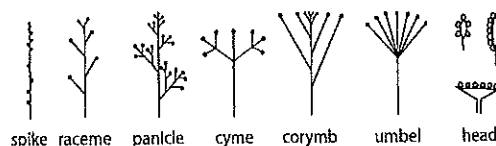
Fig. 4. Leaf arrangement. A, leaves alternate (spiral); B, leaves alternate and leaves 2-ranked (stem flexuous or zigzag); C, leaves pseudo-pinnate; D, leaves opposite; E, leaves whorled; F, leaves pseudo-whorled, terminal bud scaly, bud covered by scale-like leaves.
